Introduction

Quahog Bay Conservancy (QBC) is pleased to provide support for two (2) Harpswell senior high school students with a scholarship towards their future college education. Each recipient of the Working Waterfront Science Scholarship will be awarded \$5,000 for one year, plus a laptop. The ideal candidate will pursue a course of study that aligns with the mission and programs of QBC and be in the marine science and/or engineering related fields of study including, but not limited to: marine biology, marine science, environmental science, marine entrepreneurship, oceanography, aquaculture and aquarium science, fisheries science, ecology, chemistry, biology, marine engineering, civil engineering, mechanical engineering and marine systems engineering, etc.

The mission of the Quahog Bay Conservancy is to provide hands-on and research programs focused on revitalize the ecosystem of Quahog Bay and the environment in general.

Eligibility

To apply for funding each applicant must be:

- A senior high school student planning to attend an accredited educational institution full-time in a Bachelor of Science program
- Must have a 3.0 grade point average (grade of B) or higher
- Intend to pursue a degree in a marine or engineering related field
- Be a resident of Harpswell

Application Instructions

- **Statement of Benefit** — Provide a short, written description of why and how this scholarship would benefit you. Please include, the college you plan on attending, field of study, and goals.
- **Budget Justification** — Provide a short, written description of where the funds intend to be applied, specifically room, board, and tuition.

Requirements

Upon receiving the scholarship recipients must:

- Write a thank you letter to Quahog Bay Conservancy's Board of Directors.
- Provide your chosen field of study and a photo of you.
- Provide proof of acceptance and attendance to an accredited college/university.

By accepting this award, you have granted Quahog Bay Conservancy permission to post your name and photo to our website and social media outlets as the chosen recipient(s).
